## Ensure Proper Placement



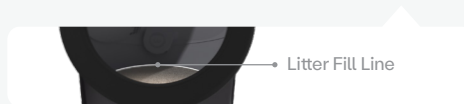
- ✓ If possible, place the Litter-Robot in the same location as the old litter box (at least during transition).
- ✓ Make sure the unit is indoors on a firm, level surface and in a cool, dry location. **Must not be touching any walls.**
- ✓ Place litter mats or rugs in front of the unit.

## Add Litter



- ✓ Use clumping litter or litter beads and crystals that are small enough to pass through the screen.
- ✓ Add litter until it meets the raised MAX fill line when spread flat (8-10 lbs or 3.6-4.5 kg). Be careful not to overfill.

## Power On



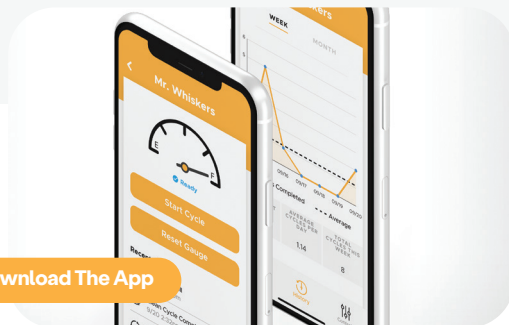
- ✓ Plug the small end of the power supply into the power input on the back of the base.
- ✓ Plug the AC/DC adapter into a wall outlet.
- ✓ Press the Power button on the control panel.

- ✓ The Litter-Robot will now perform an initial clean cycle.

Note: During initial clean cycle, the cat sensor weight scale is disabled to ensure proper calibration.

## Download The App



- ✓ Download the **Whiskers app** and follow the onboarding instructions.

# Control panel icons



## Reset

- ✓ Press the Reset button to zero the weight scale.
- ✓ A long press, while at the home position, will enter night light setting mode.
- ✓ If already cycling, press Reset to pause a cycle; press again to cancel a cycle.
- ✓ If already cycling, a long press will reset the cat sensor weight scale.



## Power

- ✓ Press the Power button to turn the robot ON or OFF.
- ✓ The robot will begin a clean cycle when power is turned on.



## Cycle

- ✓ Press the Cycle button to start a clean cycle.
- ✓ A long press, while at the home position, will enter sleep mode.
- ✓ If already cycling, press Cycle to pause; press again to resume a cycle.



## Empty

- ✓ Press the Empty button to start an empty cycle.
- ✓ A long press, while at the home position, will enter wait time setting mode.
- ✓ If already cycling, press Empty to pause.



## Connect

- ✓ Press the Connect button to turn the WiFi ON or OFF.
- ✓ A long press, while at the home position, will initiate the onboarding process.



# What do the lights mean?



## Solid Blue

Robot ready and connected



## Solid Yellow

Robot paused during cycle

Press Cycle button to continue cycling



## Flashing Blue

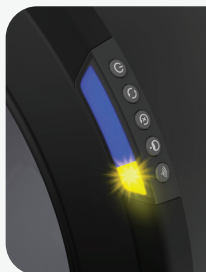
Waste drawer full



## Round Robin Yellow\*

Robot cycling

\*Yellow light moving with the rotation of the globe



## Solid Blue

WiFi Flashing Yellow

Robot in WiFi onboarding mode



## Solid Red

Cat detected and wait time countdown initiated

No action required or press Reset to cancel timing



## Solid Purple

Sleep mode enabled, within specified sleep time
